6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to hunting for mountain goat by  
7 nonresident hunters; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue, or take  
12 brown bear, grizzly bear, [MOUNTAIN GOAT,] or sheep in this state,  
13 unless personally accompanied by

14 (1) a person who is licensed as a guide-outfitter, class-A  
15 assistant guide-outfitter, or assistant guide-outfitter by the Big  
16 Game Commercial Services Board; or

17 (2) a resident over 19 years of age who is

18 (A) the spouse of the nonresident; or

19 (B) related to the nonresident, within and including  
20 the second degree of kindred, by marriage or blood.

21 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1991.
