6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pedestrian use of crosswalks."  
7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 28.35.185. PEDESTRIAN RIGHT-OF-WAY IN CROSSWALKS. (a)  
10 Except as provided in (b) of this section, the driver of a motor  
11 vehicle shall yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian who is crossing a  
12 highway, vehicular way, or area, and is within a crosswalk, or is  
13 attempting to cross a highway, vehicular way, or area at a crosswalk.

14 (b) A pedestrian may not enter a crosswalk on a highway, vehicu-  
15 lar way, or area, unless an approaching motor vehicle has an oppor-  
16 tunity to safely stop at the crosswalk. A pedestrian when crossing a  
17 highway, vehicular way, or area shall yield the right-of-way to an  
18 emergency vehicle that is using an audible or visible emergency sig-  
19 nal.

20 (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of an infrac-  
21 tion.
