A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to warning signs about the effects
7 of alcohol consumed during pregnancy."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.21.065(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A warning sign required by (a) of this section must be at
11 least 11 inches by 14 inches. The sign must read, in lettering at
12 least one-half inch high, "WARNING: Drinking alcoholic beverages such
13 as beer, wine, wine coolers, and distilled spirits during pregnancy
14 can cause birth defects." The license or permit holder shall display
15 the signs in a manner that will make them conspicuous to a person
16 purchasing or consuming alcoholic beverages on the licensed or des-
17 ignated premises.
