8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
9 \* Section 1. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:  
10 ARTICLE 9. CORPORAL CORRECTION.  
11 Sec. 14.30.700. CORPORAL CORRECTION. The principal of a public  
12 or private school, or a person employed by or contracting with a  
13 public or private school who is authorized by the principal, may  
14 impose or cause to be imposed corporal correction on a student if the  
15 corporal correction is authorized under written guidelines adopted by  
16 the governing body of the public or private school and is administered  
17 in the presence of a parent, legal guardian, or person designated by  
18 the parent or legal guardian. In this section, "corporal correction"  
19 means the application of physical force for disciplinary purposes upon  
20 a student who does not comply with the rules of the public or private  
21 school.
