6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring certain general law and home rule
7 cities to provide police protection and law
8 enforcement services; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 29.35 is amended by adding a new section to article 4
12 to read:

13 Sec. 29.35.270. MANDATORY LAW ENFORCEMENT POWERS. (a) A home
14 rule or general law city with a population of 2,000 or more shall
15 provide police protection and law enforcement services within the
16 city.

17 (b) The requirements of (a) of this section do not apply to a
18 city that is inside a borough that provides police protection and law
19 enforcement services within that city.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 29.10.200 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

21 (51) AS 29.35.270 (mandatory law enforcement powers).

22 * Sec. 3. TRANSITION. Notwithstanding sec. 4 of this Act, a home rule
23 or general law city with a population of 2,000 or more that, on June 30,
24 1990, is not already providing the services required by sec. 1 of this Act,
25 has until July 1, 1991 to begin providing the services.

26 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1990.
