Relating to the lease of land at state-

6

owned airports by the Civil Air Patrol

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Civil Air Patrol performs invaluable services to the state

9

through search and rescue and disaster relief missions; and

WHEREAS the operations of the Civil Air Patrol are conducted by

11

dedicated volunteers; and

WHEREAS the Civil Air patrol is a volunteer civilian auxiliary of the

13

United States Air Force; and

WHEREAS the State of Alaska supports the operations of the Alaska Wing

15

of the Civil Air Patrol by providing funding and equipment; and

16

WHEREAS some, but not all, Civil Air Patrol squadrons operating from

17

state-owned airports are granted use of land at those airports without

18

charge; and

WHEREAS it is illogical for the State of Alaska to provide funding for

20

the operations of the Civil Air Patrol and then to recover part of that

21

funding by charging rent for the use of land at state-owned airports;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

23

the Governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facil-

24

ities to provide rent-free space at the state-owned airport at Barrow to

25

the Barrow squadron of the Civil Air Patrol on the same terms as other

26

Civil Air Patrol squadrons in the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully re-

28

quests the Governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public

29

Facilities to amend its regulations for the lease of land at state-owned

1 airports in order to allow rent-free leases to the squadrons of the Alaska
2 Wing of the Civil Air Patrol.
