9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
10 \* Section 1. Rule 20(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legis-  
11 lature is amended to read:  
12 (a) Each house has the following standing committees with the  
13 jurisdiction indicated:  
14 Finance (all appropriation, revenue, capital improvement, and  
15 bonding measures, the executive budget, and the programs and activi-  
16 ties of the Department of Revenue)  
17 Health, Education and Social Services (the programs and activi-  
18 ties of the Department of Health and Social Services, the Department  
19 of Education, and the University of Alaska)  
20 Judiciary (the programs and activities of the Alaska Court System  
21 and the Departments of Corrections and [DEPARTMENT OF] Law, constitu-  
22 tional amendments, and the legal and substantive review of bills  
23 referred to it for that purpose)  
24 Labor and Commerce (the programs and activities of the Department  
25 of Labor relating to labor-management relations, industrial safety,  
26 unemployment compensation, and workers' compensation and the programs  
27 and activities of the Department of Commerce and Economic Development)  
28 Community and Regional Affairs (the programs and activities of  
29 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs and other matters

1 relating to political subdivisions)

2 Resources (the programs and activities of the Departments of Fish  
3 and Game, Natural Resources, and Environmental Conservation)

4 Rules (interpretation of the Uniform Rules, calendar, the inter-  
5 nal administration of the house and matters pertaining to the manage-  
6 ment of the legislature as a whole)

7 State Affairs (programs and activities of the Office of the  
8 Governor and the Departments of Administration, Military Affairs and  
9 Public Safety, and programs and activities of the Department of Trans-  
10 portation and Public Facilities relating to public facilities)

11 Transportation (programs and activities of the Department of  
12 Transportation and Public Facilities relating to transportation and  
13 other legislative matters relating to transportation).
