7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS in December of 1969 the Alaska Vocational Technical Center

(AVTEC) was established in Seward; and

WHEREAS AVTEC has provided quality vocational technical education for

citizens of the state; and

WHEREAS AVTEC has trained Alaskans for jobs in many businesses and

industries in the state for over 20 years; and

WHEREAS AVTEC has assisted over 20,000 Alaskans in achieving their

career goals and in becoming successful contributors to the economy of

the state; and

WHEREAS AVTEC has, through state-of-the-art training equipment and

instruction, successfully kept pace with rising standards in business and

WHEREAS AVTEC has helped stimulate the growth of business and industry

in the state by preparing workers for expanding occupations and careers;
