Chambers to Senator Bob Ziegler and

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS Senator Bob Ziegler served in the Territorial Legislature from
10 1957 to 1958 and in the Senate from 1965 to 1987; and

11 WHEREAS Senator Ziegler's efforts to maintain the integrity of the
12 legislative process and the flow and harmony of legislative language were
13 greatly appreciated by his colleagues; and

14 WHEREAS Senator Ziegler was affectionately known as the "Dean of the
15 Senate"; and

16 WHEREAS Senator Ziegler was respected for his extensive knowledge of
17 the rules of the legislature; and

18 WHEREAS Senator Ziegler's integrity and long legislative service
19 earned him the respect and love of his constituents and legislative col-
20 leagues; and

21 WHEREAS Senator Terry Miller served in the state legislature from 1967
22 to 1977, serving one term in the House of Representatives and two terms in
23 the Senate; and

24 WHEREAS Senator Miller served as the President of the Senate from 1973
25 to 1974 during the Eighth Legislature; and

26 WHEREAS Senator Miller was the youngest person ever to be elected to
27 the state Senate and to serve as its president; and

28 WHEREAS Senator Miller also served as the Lieutenant Governor of the
29 state from 1978 to 1982; and

1 WHEREAS during his public service Senator Miller displayed an enthusi-
2 asm and idealism, tempered by the wisdom of his pioneer family heritage,
3 that was greatly admired and respected by his constituents and legislative
4 colleagues; and

5 WHEREAS Senator Miller's legislative service and other public service
6 set a high standard of achievement for all young people in the state;

7 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that the gallery of the Senate Chambers
8 that is now known as gallery A is dedicated to Senator Bob Ziegler, and a
9 bronze plaque shall be placed on the door of gallery A to read: "ZIEGLER
10 GALLERY, dedicated to Senator Robert H. Ziegler of Ketchikan, whose father,
11 A. H. Ziegler, preceded him in service in the Territorial Legislature.
12 Senator Robert Ziegler served in the Alaska Territorial Legislature and the
13 Alaska State Legislature with honor and distinction for a total of 24
14 years, including service in the Senate from 1965 to 1987"; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the gallery of the Senate Chambers that is now
16 known as gallery B is dedicated to Senator Terry Miller, and a bronze
17 plaque shall be placed on the door of gallery B to read: "MILLER GALLERY,
18 dedicated to Senator Terry Miller of Fairbanks. At the age of 26 Senator
19 Miller was elected to the Alaska State Senate and served with honor and
20 distinction from 1969 to 1977. He was President of the Senate during the
21 Eighth Legislature and served as Alaska's Lieutenant Governor from 1978 -
22 1982."
