Establishing a Senate Special Committee

on the Public School Foundation Program.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS the legislature finds that the present system of providing
9 assistance to the public school system should be studied for possible
10 modification and improvement; and

11 WHEREAS during the period of study an alternative mechanism to the
12 existing system of financial support may be desirable;

13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on the
14 Public School Foundation Program is established to study and make recommen-
15 dations for improving the public school foundation program; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the Senate shall determine the
17 number of senators to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the
18 members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall work closely with the
20 Department of Education, the State Board of Education, and all other groups
21 concerned with state funding of education; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Special Committee on the Public
23 School Foundation Program may meet during and between sessions of the
24 Sixteenth Alaska State Legislature, and will report to the legislature its
25 findings and recommendations no later than February 1, 1990; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is terminated on the convening of
27 the First Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature.
