Establishing a Senate Special Committee

on Health Care Facilities Assessment.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS there are many persons in the state who have unmet needs for

9 adequate health care facilities; and

10 WHEREAS there has not been a comprehensive study of the extent of the

11 need for new or improved health care facilities in the state since 1982;

12 and

13 WHEREAS a comprehensive assessment of the condition of existing facil-

14 ities and the question of whether more facilities are needed is necessary

15 to most effectively plan on how to meet the future health care needs of

16 persons in the state;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Special Committee on Health Care

18 Facilities Assessment is established to study issues relating to health

19 care facilities in the state, including methods of financing their con-

20 struction or improvement, and it shall submit a report to the legislature

21 on those subjects before the convening of the Seventeenth Alaska State

22 Legislature; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Senate shall determine the

24 number of senators that should comprise the committee, appoint the members,

25 and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Special Committee on Health Care

27 Facilities Assessment may meet during the interim between the Second Regu-

28 lar Session of the Sixteenth Alaska State Legislature and the First Regular

29 Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on

- 1 the convening of the First Regular Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State
- 2 Legislature.
