A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the crime of escape."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 11.56.320(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) One commits the crime of escape in the third degree if one

5 (1) removes oneself from official detention during any lawful movement or activity
6 incident to confinement within a correctional facility for a misdemeanor; [OR]

7 (2) violates AS 11.56.340 or 11.56.350 and leaves or attempts to leave the state;

8 or

9 (3) without lawful authority removes oneself from official detention for a
10 misdemeanor, or from official detention in connection with a valid warrant, and during the
11 removal takes a propelled vehicle of a peace officer or an emergency medical vehicle.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 11.56.330(a) is amended to read:

13 (a) One commits the crime of escape in the fourth degree if, without lawful authority,
14 one removes oneself from official detention for a misdemeanor under circumstances not

amounting to escape in the third degree under AS 11.56.320(a).
