A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to transportation of alcoholic beverages in motor vehicles."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**3 * **Section 1.** AS 28.35.029(b) is amended to read:4 (b) A person may transport an open bottle, can, or other receptacle containing an
5 alcoholic beverage

6 (1) in the trunk of a motor vehicle;

7 (2) on a motor driven cycle, or behind the last upright seat in a motor home,
8 station wagon, hatchback, or similar trunkless vehicle, if the open bottle, can, or other receptacle
9 is enclosed within another container; or10 (3) [BEHIND A SOLID PARTITION THAT SEPARATES THE VEHICLE
11 DRIVER FROM THE AREA NORMALLY OCCUPIED BY PASSENGERS; OR12 (4)] if the open bottle, can, or other receptacle is in the possession of a passenger in a
13 commercial motor vehicle.
