A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act amending the definition of transportation services to exempt operators of certain
2 watercraft from the transporter license requirement; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 08.54.590(13) is amended to read:

5 (13) "transportation services" means the carriage for compensation of big game
6 hunters, their equipment, or big game animals harvested by hunters to, from, or in the field;
7 "transportation services" does not include the carriage [BY AIRCRAFT] of big game hunters,
8 their equipment, or big game animals harvested by hunters

9 (A) by watercraft licensed by the United States Coast Guard to carry
10 passengers for hire; or

11 (B) by aircraft

12 (i) on nonstop flights between state or federally maintained
13 airports; or

14 (ii) [(B)] by an air taxi operator or air carrier for which the

- 1 carriage of big game hunters, their equipment, or big game animals harvested by
2 hunters is only an incidental, as defined by the board, portion of its business;
3 * Sec. 2. AS 08.54.400(a)(4)(B) and 08.54.400(c)(4)(B) are repealed.
4 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1992.
