A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to free tuition and fees for dependents of certain state residents involved  
2 in the Persian Gulf crisis or lost in action in Southeast Asia."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 14.43.080(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A [ANY] dependent of a bona fide Alaska resident who, while serving during the  
6 hostilities involving the United States forces in Southeast Asia or the Persian Gulf, was listed  
7 by the United States Department of Defense as a prisoner of war, [OR] missing in action, or lost  
8 in action in Southeast Asia or the Persian Gulf may attend any state-supported educational  
9 institution without payment of tuition and fees.
