A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act providing for the design and construction of a secondary highway from the
2 Copper River Highway to the Richardson Highway and of a pioneer access road from the
3 Copper River Highway to Chitina."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A HIGHWAY FROM THE COPPER**
6 **RIVER HIGHWAY TO THE RICHARDSON HIGHWAY.** (a) The Department of Transportation and
7 Public Facilities shall design and construct, subject to appropriation, a secondary highway, 64 miles in
8 length, from mile 49 of the Copper River Highway to connect with the Richardson Highway by way of
9 the Tasnuna route.

10 (b) Notwithstanding AS 19.10.170(b), the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities
11 shall prepare the initial design of the Tasnuna route highway.

12 * **Sec. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PIONEER ACCESS ROAD TO**
13 **CHITINA.** (a) The Department of Transportation and Public Facilities shall design and construct,
14 subject to appropriation, a pioneer access road, 62 miles in length, from mile 49 of the Copper River

1 Highway to connect with Chitina.

2 (b) Notwithstanding AS 19.10.170(b), the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities

3 shall prepare the initial design of the Chitina highway.
