A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act authorizing certain transmission lines and interties; and providing for an effective
2 date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c), the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design
5 and construct a northeast transmission intertie between Anchorage and Fairbanks at a cost of
6 \$170,600,000.

7 * **Sec. 2.** In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c), the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design
8 and construct an intertie from Solomon Gulch to Cordova at a cost of \$73,750,000.

9 * **Sec. 3.** In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c), the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design
10 and construct the limited upgrade of the transmission line from Healy to Fairbanks at a cost of
11 \$77,500,000.

12 * **Sec. 4.** In accordance with AS 44.83.185(c), the Alaska Energy Authority is authorized to design
13 and construct a transmission intertie between Anchorage and Soldotna around the boundaries of the
14 Kenai National Wildlife Refuge at a cost of \$83,200,000.

1 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1991.
