A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to qualifications for a longevity bonus; and providing for an effective
2 date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 47.45.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, a recipient continues to qualify for bonuses during
6 the first 90 days of continuous absence and upon return to the state if the recipient is otherwise
7 qualified and is absent

8 (1) upon the orders of a physician for the purpose of receiving medical treatment;

9 or

10 (2) to provide care for a member of the recipient's immediate family who is
11 receiving nonelective inpatient or outpatient hospital services or is suffering from a terminal
12 illness or condition.

13 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1991.
