**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to introduction of bills by the supreme court; and providing for an  
2 effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 24.08.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (c) The supreme court may recommend bills it considers necessary. A bill may be  
6 delivered to the rules committee of either house with a letter signed by the chief justice  
7 requesting introduction on behalf of the court. The bill shall be introduced with the inscription  
8 "Rules Committee by Request of the Alaska Supreme Court" and it shall be considered to carry  
9 the approval of the court as to policy and effect on the budget. The court may submit a  
10 statement of purpose and effect with the bill and appear through a representative before any  
11 committee considering the legislation.

12 \* **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
