A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the licensing requirements for architects, engineers, and land
2 surveyors."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 08.48.255 is repealed and reenacted to read:

5 Sec. 08.48.255. **TEACHING.** A person who is employed by a postsecondary educational
6 institution to teach engineering courses is not required to fulfill the registration requirements of
7 this chapter during the period of employment. This section does not authorize the person to
8 perform engineering services other than teaching and performing normal academic duties,
9 including research, without being registered under this chapter. In this section, "postsecondary
10 educational institution" has the meaning given in AS 14.48.210.

11 * **Sec. 2.** (a) A person who is teaching architectural or land surveying courses under former
12 AS 08.48.255(a) when this Act takes effect may continue to teach the courses without being registered
13 under AS 08.48 until the 18-month period allowed by former AS 08.48.255(a) has expired.

14 (b) A person who is teaching architectural or land surveying courses under former

- 1 AS 08.48.255(b) when this Act takes effect may continue to teach the courses without being registered
- 2 under AS 08.48 until the one-year period allowed by former AS 08.48.255(b) has expired.
