**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to the preparation of the jury list."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 09.20.050(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) At such times as need may require, but not later than November 30 [MARCH 15]  
5 of each year, the administrative director of courts shall prepare for each judicial district a list of  
6 the names of the residents of the district who are qualified by law for jury service. If the  
7 superior court is located in different cities in the same judicial district, the administrative director  
8 shall prepare for each location of the court a list of the names of the qualified residents of that  
9 portion of the district considered to be appropriate.

10 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 09.20.050(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) The jury list shall be based on a list prepared by the Department of Revenue of all  
12 persons who filed an application for a distribution of Alaska permanent fund income under  
13 AS 43.23 during the current [PRECEDING] calendar year that shows an Alaskan address, and  
14 of all persons who volunteer for jury duty under (d) of this section. If considered necessary by

1 the administrative director of the Alaska Court System, the jury list shall incorporate a list  
2 prepared by the Department of Public Safety of all persons who hold a valid Alaska driver's  
3 license. The departments shall submit their respective lists to the Alaska Court System not later  
4 than September 30 [JANUARY 15] of each year. To the extent that it is available, the  
5 departments shall include on the lists they submit the following information for each person: first  
6 name, middle initial, and last name; mailing address, including the zip code; and birth date. The  
7 lists shall be recorded on magnetic tape compatible with Alaska Court System data processing  
8 equipment.
