**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act changing the date by which jury lists must be prepared; requiring the use of  
2 the list of the current year's permanent fund dividend applicants in preparing the jury  
3 list; and changing the date by which state departments must submit certain lists to the  
4 Alaska court system."

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 \* Section 1. AS 09.20.050(a) is amended to read:

7 (a) At such times as need may require, but not later than November 30 [MARCH 15]  
8 of each year, the administrative director of courts shall prepare for each judicial district a list of  
9 the names of the residents of the district who are qualified by law for jury service. If the  
10 superior court is located in different cities in the same judicial district, the administrative director  
11 shall prepare for each location of the court a list of the names of the qualified residents of that  
12 portion of the district considered to be appropriate.

14 (b) The jury list shall be based on a list prepared by the Department of Revenue of all

1 persons who filed an application for a distribution of Alaska permanent fund income under  
2 AS 43.23 during the current [PRECEDING] calendar year that shows an Alaskan address, and  
3 of all persons who volunteer for jury duty under (d) of this section. If considered necessary by  
4 the administrative director of the Alaska Court System, the jury list shall incorporate a list  
5 prepared by the Department of Public Safety of all persons who hold a valid Alaska driver's  
6 license. The departments shall submit their respective lists to the Alaska Court System not later  
7 than September 30 [JANUARY 15] of each year. To the extent that it is available, the  
8 departments shall include on the lists they submit the following information for each person: first  
9 name, middle initial, and last name; mailing address, including the zip code; and birth date. The  
10 lists shall be recorded on magnetic tape compatible with Alaska Court System data processing  
11 equipment.
