A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to group life and health insurance for state employees called into
2 military service; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 39.30.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (c) An eligible employee who is in the military reserve, National Guard, or state militia
6 and is called into active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States may continue
7 the insurance coverage that was in effect under this section at the time the employee enters leave
8 without pay status or terminates employment with the state. As long as the person is on active
9 duty, coverage provided under this subsection shall continue and the cost of the insurance
10 coverage shall be paid by the state, except that insurance coverage provided under this subsection
11 may not be continued for more than five consecutive years.

12 * **Sec. 2.** This Act is retroactive to August 1, 1990.

13 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
