A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to frequent traveler credit for state-paid travel."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 39.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 Sec. 39.20.155. **MILEAGE CREDIT.** An employee may not accept from a transportation
5 provider mileage credit for travel with the provider if the state agency pays the provider for the
6 travel charge, advances the travel charge to the employee, or reimburses the employee for the
7 travel charge.

8 *** Sec. 2.** AS 45.45 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 45.45.920. **MILEAGE CREDIT.** (a) A person who provides transportation for a
10 charge and who also provides additional benefits to the person's customers based on the mileage
11 earned by the customer while using the person's services shall, when a state agency pays the
12 charge for the transportation, credit the mileage account of the state agency instead of the mileage
13 account of the customer.

14 (b) A person who violates (a) of this section is guilty of a class **B** misdemeanor.

1 (c) In this section, "state agency" means a department, institution, board, commission,
2 division, authority, public corporation, committee, or other administrative unit of the executive,
3 judicial, or legislative branch of state government, including the University of Alaska, the Alaska
4 State Housing Authority, and the Alaska Railroad Corporation.
