A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to hepatitis B testing and vaccinations for volunteer emergency personnel;
2 and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 18.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 ARTICLE 3A. HEPATITIS B.

6 Sec. 18.15.250. VACCINATION PROGRAM FOR VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY
7 PERSONNEL. (a) The department shall establish a program under which hepatitis B testing and
8 vaccination is reasonably accessible at no charge to all volunteer emergency medical and rescue
9 personnel in the state.

10 (b) In this section, "volunteer emergency medical and rescue personnel" means a trauma
11 technician, medical technician, rescuer, or paramedic who is an active volunteer with a first
12 responder service, a rescue service, an ambulance service, or a fire department that provides
13 emergency medical or rescue services as part of its duties.

14 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
