## A BILL

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act making appropriations for water rescue training and equipment and for hazardous  
2 materials training and equipment; and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. The sum of \$125,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of  
5 Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for  
6 purchase of emergency water rescue equipment and two emergency rescue workboats and trailers.

7 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of  
8 Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for training  
9 of dive teams from throughout the Cook Inlet region in cold water rescue.

10 \* Sec. 3. The sum of \$65,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of  
11 Transportation and Public Facilities, Alaska international airports system, Anchorage International Airport  
12 for emergency water rescue equipment, an emergency rescue workboat and trailer, and water rescue  
13 training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992.

14 \* Sec. 4. The sum of \$55,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Military

1 and Veterans' Affairs, Alaska Air National Guard, Anchorage for emergency water rescue equipment,  
2 an emergency rescue workboat and trailer, and water rescue training for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
3 1992.

4 \* Sec. 5. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of  
5 Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for  
6 purchase of a command mobile hazardous materials decontamination facility.

7 \* Sec. 6. The sum of \$24,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of  
8 Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for training  
9 of personnel to respond to hazardous materials incidents.

10 \* Sec. 7. The sum of \$64,400 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of  
11 Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the Municipality of Anchorage for  
12 equipment necessary to respond to a hazardous materials incidents.

13 \* Sec. 8. This Act takes effect July 1, 1991.
