A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act making a special appropriation to the Alaska Legislative Council for a study to
 2 determine which goods and services provided by state agencies can be provided by the
 3 private sector under an award after completion of a competitive sealed bidding or proposal
 4 process; and providing for an effective date."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

6 * Section 1. The sum of \$125,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Alaska Legislative
 7 Council to pay for a study to be performed by private individuals or entities to determine which goods
 8 and services provided by the agencies of the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of the state,
 9 including the University of Alaska, the Alaska Railroad Corporation, the Alaska Housing Finance
 10 Corporation, and the Alaska State Housing Authority, can be provided by the private sector under an
 11 award after completion of a competitive sealed bid or proposal process in which state agencies may
 12 compete, without reducing the quality or the quantity of the goods or services being provided. It is the
 13 intent of the legislature that the completed study be submitted to the legislature on or before the first day
 14 of the Second Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature and that the legislature hold hearings

1 on the completed study.

2 * Sec. 2. The appropriation made by this Act lapses June 30, 1992.

3 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
