A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to notice of adoption of emergency regulations; and providing for an  
2 effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 44.62.250 is amended to read:

5           Sec. 44.62.250. EMERGENCY REGULATIONS. A regulation or order of repeal may  
6 be adopted as an emergency regulation or order of repeal if a state agency makes a written  
7 finding, including a statement of the facts that constitute the emergency, that the adoption of the  
8 regulation or order of repeal is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
9 health, safety, or general welfare. The requirements of AS 44.62.060 and 44.62.190 - 44.62.210  
10 do not apply to the initial adoption of emergency regulations; however, upon adoption of an  
11 emergency regulation the adopting agency shall immediately submit a copy of it to the lieutenant  
12 governor for filing and for publication in the Alaska Administrative Register, and within five  
13 days after filing by the lieutenant governor [ADOPTION] the agency shall give notice of the  
14 adoption in accordance with AS 44.62.190(a). Failure to give the required notice by the end of

- 1 the 10th day automatically repeals the regulation.
- 2 \* **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
