A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the use of a helmet by minors when operating or riding as a
2 passenger on certain motor vehicles."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 28.35.247. **MINORS REQUIRED TO WEAR HELMET ON CERTAIN MOTOR**
6 **VEHICLES.** A person under the age of 18 years may not operate or ride as a passenger on a
7 motorcycle or an off-road vehicle on public land or on a roadway unless the person wears a full-
8 face helmet that meets the requirements set out in AS 28.05.081(c). In this section, "off-road
9 vehicle" means a motor vehicle with three or four tires that has an engine displacement of less
10 than 600 cubic centimeters and a total dry weight of less than 600 pounds or a snowmobile.
