A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act related to the licensing of mechanical administrators; and providing for an
2 effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** Section 11(a), ch. 132, SLA 1988, is amended to read:

5 (a) Notwithstanding AS 08.40.230, 08.40.270, and 08.40.300, as added by sec. 9 of this
6 Act, a person may qualify for and receive without examination a license as a mechanical
7 administrator in those categories of mechanical administration for which the person is qualified,
8 if the person

9 (1) has functioned as a mechanical administrator in the state during five of the
10 10 years [THE TWO YEARS] before June 9, 1988; and

11 (2) applies for licensure before May 1, 1992 [JULY 1, 1989].

12 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
