A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act extending the statute of limitations in criminal prosecutions of certain sex offenses  
2 where the victim is a minor."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 12.10.020(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) Even if the general time limitation has expired, a prosecution under AS 11.41.410 -  
6 11.41.460, AS 11.66.110 - 11.66.130, former AS 11.41.430, or former AS 11.51.130(a)(4), for  
7 an offense committed against a person under the age of 18, [16] may be commenced at any time  
8 [WITHIN ONE YEAR AFTER THE CRIME IS REPORTED TO A PEACE OFFICER OR THE  
9 PERSON REACHES THE AGE OF 16, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST. THIS SUBSECTION  
10 DOES NOT EXTEND THE PERIOD OF LIMITATION BY MORE THAN FIVE YEARS].

11 \* Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. AS 12.10.020(c), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to all  
12 offenses committed on or after the effective date of this Act, and to all offenses that could have been  
13 prosecuted under AS 12.10.020(c) on the day before the effective date of this Act.
