A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to motor vehicle registration; and providing for an effective date."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1. INTENT.** It is the intent of the legislature that the additional motor vehicle registration
4 fees collected as a result of this Act will be used to provide grants to municipalities for the purpose of
5 paying the cost of transporting motor vehicles that are at the end of their useful life to recycling centers.

6 * **Sec. 2.** AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

7 **Sec. 28.10.425. RECYCLING REGISTRATION FEE.** In addition to the other fees
8 imposed under this chapter, an annual \$2 recycling registration fee is imposed and shall be
9 collected for each motor vehicle upon registration or renewal of registration of the motor vehicle.
10 The legislature may appropriate money collected under this section to the motor vehicle recycling
11 grant fund established by AS 44.47.070 to pay the cost of transporting junk or abandoned motor
12 vehicles to recycling centers.

13 * **Sec. 3.** AS 44.47 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 **ARTICLE 1A. MOTOR VEHICLE RECYCLING GRANT FUND.**

1 Sec. 44.47.070. MOTOR VEHICLE RECYCLING GRANT FUND. The motor vehicle
2 recycling grant fund is established in the department. Subject to legislative appropriation, grants
3 shall be made by the department from this fund to a municipality for the purpose of transporting
4 junk or abandoned motor vehicles to recycling centers.
5 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 1993.
