A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act exempting certain persons from jury service."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 09.20.030 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 09.20.030. EXEMPTIONS. A person may claim exemption and may be excused
5 from service as a juror if it is shown that

6 (1) the person's health, the health or proper care of the person's family, a
7 permanent physical or mental disability, or other substantial hardship expected to last more than
8 two years makes it necessary for the person to be excused;

9 (2) the person is an expectant or nursing mother;

10 (3) the person has no access to day care provided by the court in that
11 community, is not regularly employed for 30 hours a week or more, and has custody of a
12 child under six years of age who is not enrolled in a head start or state licensed day care
13 program; [,] or

14 (4) [IF] the person is a judicial officer.
