## A BILL

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to applications for permanent fund dividends for minors; and providing  
2 for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 43.23.005(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) A parent, guardian, or other authorized representative may claim a permanent fund  
6 dividend [ON BEHALF OF AN UNEMANCIPATED MINOR OR] on behalf of a disabled or  
7 an incompetent individual who is eligible to receive a payment under this section. A parent,  
8 guardian, or other authorized representative with physical custody of an unemancipated  
9 minor who is eligible for a dividend may claim the dividend on behalf of the minor.

10 \* Sec. 2. AS 43.23.015(d) is amended to read:

11 (d) The application and certification of residency [OF AN UNEMANCIPATED  
12 INDIVIDUAL UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE OR] of a disabled or an incompetent individual  
13 must be signed by the individual's parent, legal guardian, or other authorized representative. The  
14 application and certification of residency of an unemancipated minor must be signed by

1 ~~every parent, legal guardian, or other authorized representative who has physical custody~~  
2 of that minor.

3 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1993.
