FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act extending workers' compensation coverage to certain high school students in work-
2 study programs."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * Section 1. AS 23.30.237 is amended to read:

5 Sec. 23.30.237. HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN WORK-STUDY PROGRAMS AS
6 EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE. An individual who is enrolled for credit at a public high school
7 in a course that combines academic instruction with work experience outside the school for a
8 public or private [NONPROFIT] employer is an employee of the state for the purposes of this
9 chapter while the individual is performing the work experience. Weekly compensation for
10 disability or death under this section may not be less than the initial payment of compensation
11 under AS 23.30.175.
