A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the penalty for providing alcoholic beverages to a person under the
2 age of 21; and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 04.16.051 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (d) A person acting with criminal negligence who violates this section is guilty of a class
6 C felony.

7 * Sec. 2. AS 04.16.180(a) is amended to read:

8 (a) Except as provided in AS 04.11.015, AS 04.16.051, 04.16.200 - 04.16.210 [AS
9 04.16.200 - 04.16.210], and AS 04.21.065, a person who violates a provision of this title or a
10 regulation adopted by the board is guilty, upon conviction, of a class A misdemeanor. Each
11 violation is a separate offense.

12 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1992.
