A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act requiring the Department of Health and Social Services to provide voter
2 registration information to a person seeking public assistance."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * Section 1. AS 47.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 47.05.090. VOTER REGISTRATION. A state resident, who will be 18 years of age
6 or older within 90 days, who applies to the Department of Health and Social Services for general
7 relief, Medicaid, aid to families with dependent children, adult public assistance, or food stamps
8 shall at the time of application be advised by the department that the resident may also register
9 to vote. The department shall use a form for voter registration prepared by the division of
10 elections and shall forward completed forms to the division of elections. The department shall
11 prominently display notice of the right to apply for voter registration at each place that the public
12 may apply for assistance under AS 47.07 or AS 47.25.
