A BILL  
FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act permitting the use of polygraph examination of correctional officers and of  
2 applicants for employment as correctional officers."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 23.10.037(b) is amended to read:

5 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section do not apply to the state or a political  
6 subdivision of the state in the hiring and the employment of [WHEN DEALING WITH] police  
7 officers [IN ITS EMPLOY OR WITH PERSONS APPLYING TO BE EMPLOYED AS POLICE  
8 OFFICERS]. In this subsection, "police officers" includes

9 (1) officers and employees of the Department of Transportation and Public  
10 Facilities who are stationed at an international airport and have been designated to have the  
11 general police powers authorized under AS 02.15.230(a);

12 (2) correctional officers employed by the state or a political subdivision of the  
13 state to operate a correctional facility other than a juvenile correctional facility.
