A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act requiring drug and alcohol tests for school bus drivers."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 14.09 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 Sec. 14.09.030. DRUG TESTING FOR SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS. (a) A school district
5 or regional educational attendance area that provides for the transportation of pupils shall require
6 that the drivers of motor vehicles used to transport pupils submit to testing for the improper use
7 of drugs and alcohol. The testing program must include random testing. A driver who tests
8 positive for the improper use of drugs or alcohol may be disciplined, including termination from
9 employment.

10 (b) The department shall adopt regulations to implement this section. The regulations
11 must include a provision for a hearing before discipline is imposed.
