A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act authorizing moose ranching."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 16.40.010 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 16.40.010. DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS BUFFALO, MOOSE, OR [AND] MUSK
5 OXEN. Whenever it is determined by the department that a surplus [EXISTS IN THE HERDS]
6 of buffalo, moose, or [AND] musk oxen exists [UNDER ITS CONTROL], the department may,
7 under regulations adopted by it, grant the surplus or portions of it to persons, groups,
8 associations, partnerships, or corporations for the purpose of raising and breeding the animals as
9 domestic stock for commercial purposes, or for scientific and educational purposes. A person,
10 group, association, partnership, or corporation may receive animals only after proving to the
11 satisfaction of the department

- 12 (1) intent to raise and breed the animals; and
13 (2) possession of facilities for maintaining the animals under positive control.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 16.40.020 is amended to read:

1 Sec. 16.40.020. SALE OF MEAT. The sale of buffalo, moose, or musk oxen meat
2 resulting from the slaughter of animals obtained under AS 16.40.010, or their offspring is
3 authorized.
