**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to salaries for officers and employees who are not members of a  
2 collective bargaining unit and to salaries for certain employees of the Prince William  
3 Sound Community College; and providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 \* Section 1. AS 39.27.011(a) is repealed and reenacted to read:

6 (a) The following monthly basic salary schedule is approved as the pay plan for classified  
7 and partially exempt employees in the executive branch of the state government who are not  
8 members of a collective bargaining unit established under the authority of the Public Employment  
9 Relations Act and employees of the legislature under AS 24.10 and AS 24.20:

24 \* Sec. 2. EMPLOYEES OF THE JUDICIAL AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES, AND CERTAIN  
25 EXEMPT EMPLOYEES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH. The following employees are entitled to  
26 receive salary adjustments comparable to those received by the classified and partially exempt employees  
27 of the executive branch under AS 39.27.011(a) as that subsection is reenacted in sec. 1 of this Act:

- 28 (1) permanent and temporary employees of the judicial branch;  
29 (2) permanent and temporary employees of the legislative branch, including staff of the  
30 ombudsman's office;  
31 (3) permanent and temporary employees of the executive branch who are in the exempt

1 service under AS 39.25, who are not members of a collective bargaining unit established under the  
2 Public Employment Relations Act (AS 23.40), and who are not otherwise covered by AS 39.27.011(a).

3 \* Sec. 3. EMPLOYEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA. (a) The employees of the University  
4 of Alaska who are not members of a collective bargaining unit are entitled to receive salary increases  
5 in accordance with the compensation policy of the board of regents of the University of Alaska.

6 (b) The employees of Prince William Sound Community College who have not received salary  
7 increases during the last four years because of a collective bargaining dispute are entitled to receive  
8 salary increases comparable to the increases granted other employees of the university during the period  
9 of the dispute.

10 \* Sec. 4. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1992.

11 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
