**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to the appointment, removal, term, and personnel classification of the  
2 person who administers laws relating to workers' compensation."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 23.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5           Sec. 23.30.003. **DIRECTOR.** (a) The commissioner of labor shall appoint a person to  
6 administer the provisions of this chapter. A person appointed under this section

7                   (1) is subject to confirmation by a majority of the board at the first meeting of  
8 the full board following the appointment and may not serve if not confirmed at that meeting;

9                   (2) is in the exempt service under AS 39.25.110;

10                   (3) serves for a term of two years and may be reappointed for an unlimited  
11 number of terms; a person who is reappointed is subject to confirmation under (1) of this  
12 subsection; and

13                   (4) may only be removed from office during a term as provided under (b) of this  
14 section.

1           (b) The board may remove a person appointed under (a) of this section for good cause,  
2           if two-thirds of the board vote in favor of the removal. A person removed from office under this  
3           subsection may not be reappointed to the office.
