A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to operations of certain state agencies; and providing for an effective
2 date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * Section 1. AS 08.01.065(c) is repealed and reenacted to read:

5 (c) The department shall establish fee levels under (a) of this section so that the total
6 amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for
7 the occupation. The department may establish fee levels that exceed the regulatory costs for an
8 occupation only upon approval by the board that regulates the occupation. In this subsection,
9 "regulatory costs" means direct and indirect costs of the department that are attributable to
10 regulation of an occupation plus

11 (1) all costs of the board that regulates the occupation if the board regulates only
12 one occupation; or

13 (2) the direct and indirect costs of a board that are attributable to the occupation
14 if the board regulates more than one occupation.

2 (b) Every [AFTER JANUARY 1, 1979, EVERY] passenger vehicle registration plate,
3 except as specifically provided in AS 28.10.181, shall have displayed upon it

4 (1) [THE ALASKA FLAG;

5 (2) THE TRADITIONAL COLORS OF YELLOW-GOLD AND BLUE;

6 (3) THE SLOGAN "THE LAST FRONTIER";

7 (4)] the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued;

8 (2) [(5)] the name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and

9 (3) [(6)] the registration year number or expiration date for which time it is
10 validated; the registration year number or expiration date may be part of the license plate or
11 contained on a suitable sticker or tab device issued by the department; however, only one sticker
12 or tab device may be issued for each pair of plates and the sticker or tab device must be
13 affixed to the rear plate.

14 * Sec. 3. AS 37.17.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

15 (f) Each year the legislature may appropriate from the endowment an amount not to
16 exceed 10 percent of the endowment income for the previous year. Appropriations may only be
17 used for projects related to science or technology.

18 * Sec. 4. Section 4, ch. 81, SLA 1981, as amended by sec. 1, ch. 25, SLA 1988, is amended to read:

19 Sec. 4. Section 3 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1992 [JUNE 30, 1998].

20 * Sec. 5. AS 08.01.065(b), AS 08.62.040(a)(4)(B), and AS 28.10.161(c) are repealed.

21 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect July 1, 1992.
