A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds in the amount of
2 \$295,295,454 for the purpose of paying the cost of water, sewer, waste disposal, and health
3 care facility capital projects; and providing for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of water, sewer, waste disposal, and health care
6 facility capital projects, general obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more than
7 \$295,295,454 shall be issued and sold. The full faith, credit, and resources of the state are pledged to
8 the payment of the principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on the bonds. The bonds
9 shall be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of issuance.

10 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of the bonds is authorized by the qualified voters of the state, a special fund
11 of the state to be known as the "1992 Water, Sewer, Waste Disposal, and Health Care Facility
12 Construction Fund" shall be established, to which shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds
13 described in sec. 1 of this Act except for the accrued interest and premiums.

14 * Sec. 3. (a) The amount of \$80,181,989 is appropriated from the "1992 Water, Sewer, Waste

1 Disposal, and Health Care Facility Construction Fund" to the Department of Environmental Conservation
 2 to be allocated among the following projects to enhance village safe water in the following cities and
 3 unincorporated communities for the purposes and in the amounts stated subject to reallocation between
 4 projects under AS 37.07.080(e):

11 (g) The sum of \$14,700,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health
12 and Social Services for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Kodiak Island Borough Hospital
13 and Intermediate Care Facility for construction of the facility, contingent on the Kodiak Island Borough
14 appropriating at least \$4,900,000 for the construction. The borough may make an in kind contribution
15 to satisfy up to five percent of this requirement.

16 (h) The sum of \$5,300,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health
17 and Social Services for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Seward General Hospital for
18 renovation and construction of the hospital, contingent on the City of Seward appropriating at least
19 \$1,800,000 for the renovation and construction. The city may make an in kind contribution to satisfy
20 up to five percent of this requirement.

21 (i) The sum of \$15,800,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health
22 and Social Services for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Ketchikan General Hospital for
23 renovation and construction of the hospital, contingent on the City of Ketchikan appropriating at least
24 \$5,300,000 for the renovation and construction. The city may make an in kind contribution to satisfy
25 up to five per cent of this requirement.

26 * Sec. 4. If the issuance of the bonds is authorized by the qualified voters of the state, the amount
27 of \$1,033,534 or as much of that amount as is found necessary is appropriated from the general fund
28 of the state to the state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay expenses
29 incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this Act. The amounts expended from the
30 appropriation authorized by this section shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the

1 * Sec. 5. The amount withdrawn from the public facility planning fund for the purpose of advance
2 planning for the improvements financed under this Act shall be reimbursed to the fund from the proceeds

4 * Sec. 6. The unexpended and unobligated balances of the appropriations made in sec. 3 of this Act
5 lapse under AS 37.25.020 and are appropriated to the state bond committee to redeem bonds sold under
