**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Relating to the twenty-fifth annual Boys' State.**

**2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**3 WHEREAS** the twenty-fifth annual Boys' State will be held June 25 - July 3, 1991, at Camp  
**4 Carrol** on Fort Richardson under the sponsorship of the American Legion and cooperating organizations;  
**5 and**

**6 WHEREAS** this fine annual program is dedicated to increasing the delegates' awareness of their  
**7 future roles** in state and local government as well as promoting interest and knowledge about the  
**8 operation** of our system of government; and

**9 WHEREAS** it is only through an admirable combination of volunteer effort and the enterprising  
**10 talents** of generous individuals who do not receive government or taxpayer monetary support that this  
**11 week-long** youth citizenship exercise known as Boys' State takes place; and

**12 WHEREAS** the legislature encourages state and local legislators and other public officials and  
**13 agencies** to volunteer their services and to provide copies of state publications and materials related to  
**14 the program;**

**15 BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature applauds the sponsors of and participants  
**16 in the** twenty-fifth annual Boys' State program; commends to the attention of government officials and  
**17 agencies** and private individuals and organizations the opportunity to support and participate in this

1 exercise in youth citizenship; and promises to continue to provide legislative materials, advice, and  
2 encouragement to the Boys' State program as it does to similar worthy civic efforts.
