A RESOLUTION

1 Declaring April 17, 18, and 19, 1992, as Disabled American Veterans Days.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 WHEREAS the Disabled American Veterans, a national organization, first chartered a chapter
4 in Anchorage on March 5, 1959; and

5 WHEREAS, in October 1988, the Anchorage chapter opened the first veterans' crisis center in
6 the state and, since that time, has served more than 3,000 veterans and their widows and dependents;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, in June 1989, through the combined efforts of chapters in Anchorage, Fairbanks,
9 and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, the Alaska Department of the Disabled American Veterans was
10 established and first elected chapter officers on September 9, 1989; and

11 WHEREAS the Alaska Department of the Disabled American Veterans will convene its third
12 annual convention in Anchorage on April 17 - 19, 1992;

13 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature declares April 17, 18, and 19, 1992, as
14 Disabled American Veterans Days in Alaska.
