**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Commending Alaska citizens serving in the armed forces in the Persian Gulf and urging**  
2 **the President and the United States Congress to seek an end to the war.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4       **WHEREAS** President Bush has called on Alaska citizens serving in the United States armed  
5 forces to participate in America's war efforts in the Persian Gulf; and

6       **WHEREAS** these Alaska citizens are serving United States interests with dedication, honor, and  
7 commitment; and

8       **WHEREAS** the number of Alaska citizens called on to serve in the Persian Gulf is likely to  
9 increase;

10       **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature commends the bravery and dedication of  
11 the state's military personnel who are serving in the Persian Gulf and wishes them a safe and quick  
12 return home; and be it

13       **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature urges President Bush and the United  
14 States Congress to seek a peaceful resolution of the conflict and to end the war as soon as possible.

15       **COPIES** of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United  
16 States; the Honorable Dan Quayle, Vice-President of the United States and President of the U.S. Senate;
