A RESOLUTION

1 **Proposing amendments to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to the reservation**
2 **of powers for the people, residual power of the state, and the power of taxation.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** Article I, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new section to
5 read:

6 **SECTION 24. RESERVATION OF POWER FOR THE PEOPLE.** Powers not
7 specifically enumerated in this constitution for exercise by the State are reserved for and by the
8 people.

9 * **Sec. 2.** Article IX, Section 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and Article XII, Section 8,
10 Constitution of the State of Alaska, are repealed.

11 * **Sec. 3.** The amendments proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state
12 at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and
13 the election laws of the state.
