**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to the duties,  
2 appointment, confirmation, and removal of the head of the agency that regulates the  
3 business of insurance.**

**4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**5 \* Section 1. Article III, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new section to  
6 read:**

**7 SECTION 28. OFFICE REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE. The head  
8 of the office of State government that administers laws regulating the business of insurance shall  
9 be designated the regulator of insurance. The duties and powers of the regulator shall be as  
10 provided by law. The regulator of insurance shall be appointed by the governor, subject to  
11 confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session, and may be  
12 removed as provided by law. If the office that regulates the business of insurance is allocated  
13 as a principal department of the State, then the head of that principal department shall be  
14 appointed, confirmed, and removed as provided by Section 25 of this article.**

**15 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state  
16 at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and**

**1 the election laws of the state.**
