**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Disapproving Executive Order No. 80.**

**2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**3 WHEREAS the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska,**  
**4 has proposed to transfer the functions of the Professional Teaching Practices Commission to the**  
**5 Department of Education by Executive Order No. 80; and**

**6 WHEREAS the governor has submitted Executive Order No. 80 to the presiding officer of each**  
**7 house of the legislature as required by AS 24.08.210; and**

**8 WHEREAS art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska provides that unless disapproved**  
**9 within 60 days of a regular session by resolution concurred in by a majority of the members of the**  
**10 legislature in joint session, an executive order becomes effective at a date designated by the governor;**  
**11 and**

**12 WHEREAS Executive Order No. 80 does not adequately reflect legislative policy;**

**13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No. 80 is disapproved.**
